## AUTHOR GUIDELINES

### AIMS AND SCOPE

**South East European Journal of Sustainable Development (SEEJSD ISSN (print) 2545-4463 ISSN (online) 2545-4471) is an official international peer-reviewed journal.**

The journal is **interdisciplinary publication including but not limited to economic development and policy, ecology and spatial planning, technology, education and science. It is published twice a year in English language.**

### TYPE OF PUBLICATIONS

The journal publishes: **original scientific papers, reviews, short communications, technical notes, case studies** and **professional papers** from all fields related to sustainable development. Experimental data should be prepared in a way to enable reproduction and verification of the gained results on which the conclusions are based.

As **original scientific papers** are reported contributions if they have not been previously published or been submitted elsewhere. The papers should not exceed 5000 words.

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The manuscript should contain: title, authors names and addresses, abstract, key words, introduction, experimental or theoretical background, results and discussion, acknowledgement (if desired) and references.

**The title page** should include the title, authors and their affiliations (institute where the work was carried out), complete address of the corresponding author including an e-mail address and phone number and an Abstract.

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**Abstract.** Each manuscript should be presented with an abstract containing maximum 300 words. It should briefly explain the aim of the research, methods or procedures, significant results and conclusions. It is recommended to avoid any abbreviations and references in the abstract. The text of the abstract should contain as many key words as possible.
